beat • parenthetical • scene heading • shot list • slugline • storyboard • two-column script



Slugline order

Special info → INT./EXT. → location → shot type → subject → time of day.



Format spec

Courier or Courier New, 12pt. 1" margins on description, 2" inset on dialogue.



Parenthetical

A short delivery note in parens under a character's name. Use sparingly.



Shot list

Every shot the camera needs, numbered in order. 15–30 shots for a 2–6 min film.



Storyboard panel

Shot type, camera movement, action summary, dialogue/sound cue.



Beat

A pause or turning point marked in the script to control pacing.

ALL CAPS in a script: a speaking character's first-appearance name, sound effects/off-screen sounds, and camera direction. Nothing else.
