Calligraphic Brush

Mimics an angled pen nib. The stroke gets thicker or thinner depending on the direction you draw.



Scatter Brush

Scatters copies of an object randomly along a path, good for leaves, stars, or texture.



Art Brush

Stretches a single piece of art along the entire length of a path, good for ribbons, rope, or a single continuous line texture.



Bristle Brush

Simulates a real paintbrush's bristles, including pressure and angle. The most painterly of the five brush types.



Pattern Brush

Repeats a set of tiles along a path, with separate artwork for straight sides and corners, good for borders and frames.



Generate Pattern

Object > Pattern > Make. Live-tiles your artwork as you adjust tile type, spacing, and overlap, before saving it as a swatch.

A pattern's tile is its repeating unit. Watch for the dashed bounding box in Generate Pattern mode to see exactly where one repeat ends and the next begins.
