Setting	What it controls	Watch out for
Kerning	Space between one specific pair of letters.	Fix awkward gaps (like "AV" or "To") one pair at a time.
Tracking	Space evenly across a whole selection.	Great for headlines. Don't overdo it on body text.
Leading	Vertical space between lines, baseline to baseline.	Too tight = hard to read; too loose = lines feel disconnected.
Horiz./Vert. Scale	Stretches or squishes letterforms.	Avoid this: distorts the type designer's original shapes. Use a different weight instead.
Baseline Shift	Moves characters up/down without resizing.	Used for superscript/subscript effects.
