Type Object	How it behaves	Best for
Point Type	Grows horizontally forever unless you add a line break.	Headlines, short labels.
Area Type	Wraps automatically inside a closed shape.	Paragraphs, body copy.
Type on a Path	Flows along an open or closed path's contour.	Badges, logos, curved headlines.
